Updates were made to the Library Book Shipping Tool on April 13, 2013.

If you select meter as your method of payment, you will be required to enter your 7-digit meter number in your order.

Reminder: If you pay for shipments by postage stamp, you must select "Postage Stamps" as the method of payment. Only select "meter" as your method of payment if you are paying by meter.
