The following is a rough chart to outline CLA's advocacy plans for the next few months:

Month	Activity	Notes
October/ November	Welcome message to all newly elected and reelected MPs	Send a letter to all elected Members of Parliament
October/ November	Track strategic timing for return to Ottawa, new House of Commons calendar, new Cabinet (including policy staff) and return of committees	
November	Engage EC in in-depth conversation about advocacy plans	
November	Send letters with policy documents to policy staff	Focus on: -long-form census -copyright in the TPP -LAC mandate -C-51?
November- December	With CLA eBooks taskforce, determine exact federal asks and bring them forward to relevant policy staff	
December onwards	Engage members in grassroots efforts to meet their local MPs in their riding.	
January-February	Meetings with relevant policy staff and a few strategic MPs	Choose a date or multiple dates when EC members can join CLA staff?
February-March	Federal Budget preparation and follow up	
June 3	CLA Forum: Parliamentarian breakfast panel	Possibility of one MP per party/ possibility of MP, MPP and city councillor
