Terms of Reference: Education in Canada is mandated at the provincial level.

Post-secondary institutions across the country provide undergraduate and graduate programs in education including professional development to K-12 teachers for the provinces and territories that they serve. While there are currently non-association local networks that include those interested in issues that relate to teacher training at both the undergraduate and graduate level, creating a national network of librarians who serve these students and faculty will enable sharing and collaboration on issues unique to the field of education and teacher education that have so far been primarily focused on at the provincial level. Interested members will collaborate, communicate, support and promote understandings about issues in the field of professional teacher education and impacts on all aspects of library services and future trends.

Plan of activities:

- Facilitate, conduct and communicate research and best practices of participants. Promote discussion via electronic communication (listserv) with network members and other members of CLA.
- Extend communication to include two teleconferences in a year, and face-to-face meetings
- when possible at CLA conferences across the country. Collaborate with and promote the Voices for School Libraries Network.
