Details

The University of New Brunswick Libraries invites applications from dynamic, collaborative and innovative individuals for the position of **Director of Learning & Research Services, UNB Libraries**. UNB is a comprehensive university, with strong undergraduate and graduate programs, diverse research strengths, and several professional degree programs. We are the province's largest university with approximately 10,000 students across two campuses. UNB Libraries have been at the forefront of innovation, redefining the role of academic libraries over the past decades in support of the learning, research and teaching of the university.

Reporting to the Dean of Libraries, the Director of Learning & Research Services is a member of the senior management team at UNB Libraries, providing strategic direction and leadership across the library system. Three of five libraries at UNB fall under the oversight of the Dean: Harriet Irving Library, the Science & Forestry Library, and the Engineering & Computer Science Library. Responsibilities, primarily in the context of services, include strategic planning and development; coordination, evaluation and promotion; financial planning; and fostering a positive working and learning environment. Currently, library services overseen by this position include research support and reference, instruction, service points, and development of library spaces. The Director of Learning & Research Services builds collaborations and partnerships within and beyond the libraries, and will be expected to represent the libraries internally and externally.
